DWC COMMITTEES

Ways & Means – The following fundraising projects have been held to support our Philanthropic donations: Script Gift Cards; Pick Three Lottery Tickets; Plant Sales; Bake Sales; and Children’s Resales.

Membership – Help with the recruitment of new members; new member orientation; initiation ceremony; keep a record of members’ hours; host the Membership table at monthly general meetings with name tags and Guest Book.

Programs/Hospitality – Plan programs for the coming year and Hospitality when needed. Plan October event for Breast Cancer awareness month (BINGO/Bunko)

Arts & Culture – Plans social and educational artistic endeavors for club members and the community. Since 1974, the club has sponsored art education in the community with art supply donations and Community Art Projects (Pandemic 2021) and The Youth Art Fair and Exhibit (1974-1984, 1987-present).

Environment – Help plan environmental projects. Projects have included Adopt-A-Highway; Pollinator Gardens; “Soles for Souls”; bras for “Free the Girls”; empty Pill Bottles; Pop Can Tabs; Styrofoam; and items for SCARCE.

Civic Engagement & Outreach – Past projects have been School Supplies Drive; Little Store at Burgess Square; Soap Collection; Giving Tree (toys for needy children) and Gift Wrapping of the Toys; Spring Bags for residents of Burgess Square; and Mother’s Day Bags for women in the Women’s Shelter.

Social – Help plan social activities. Past events have been Cocktails at 7:00; Breakfast Club; Lunch at College of DuPage; Flower Arrangement; Bunco and Travel Group.

Health & Wellness – Past projects have been in the past: Blood Drive, TLC Camp, Secret Sister, and Collecting for Peoples Resource Center.

Long-Range Planning – Help decide what we want for our club over the next few years.

Nominating – Committee to find members who would like to take an officer position (Executive Board) for the next year.

Philanthropy – Committee to help decide where we will donate the money we raised during the year.

Yearbook – Go to businesses to solicit ads for our Yearbook.
